ARTBO 27 - 30 OCTOBER CORFERIAS

ARTBO or International Art Fair of Bogotá, is the quintessential meeting point for the art market in Latin America. Each year, ARTBO summons national and international galleries carefully selected to achieve a show of the highest quality, where both a specialized audience and the general public can enjoy and purchase the pieces on display. The main section will have 57 galleries from 29 different cities from all over the world. **INSIDER TIP** You can't forget to stop by the Artecamara section, which showcases the work of young Colombian artists, with no gallery representation, who are selected by a curator through a national and public call for applications.



VILLANOS EN BERMUDAS CALLE 56 #5-21

No big letter signs, no ads, just mouth to mouth. This is Villanos en Bermudas, a new restaurant in Chapinero Alto where chefs Sergio Meza (Mexico) and Nicolas Lopez (Argentina) are rocking the stage. Their proposal is something very different, breaking all boundaries of traditional

restaurants in the city. Before you book, you should know that at Villanos the customer is never right but the chef always is! The restaurant is divided into three floors with two open kitchens and a cool bar/lounge on the second floor. The piece de resistance definitely is the "cooking lab" where all the magic happens, and where you see the chefs live in action. Foodies will experience a night of surprises and a no nonsense cuisine. The menu changes every week and consists of 7 dishes, mainly using organic vegetables, local grown ingredients, eye-catching presentations and most of all: amazing flavors. INSIDER TIP Book a seat at the cooking lab on the third floor. Since the menu changes constantly it's hard to recommend anything, but usually they should have their homemade bread which is served with egg yolk smooth as butter.



BUNGALOW

CRA. 13 # 83-47

Bogota has been waiting quite a while for a new rooftop bar! **BUNGALOW** opened in the middle of the Zona Rosa just a few months ago and is already becoming a favorite spot amongst locals. From the DJ booth to the centerpiece cocktail Bar, its interior design is funky and it makes it feel like you are in a tropical destination. The loungy atmosphere is ideal to start the night with some cocktails at sunset or for a crazy party with the best electronic beats. **INSIDER TIP** You'll find **440 music hall** just one floor below Bungalow which offers
