Neighbor and celebrated architect Simon Velez designed all of the new architectural aspects including an iron and glass roof supported by recycled petroleum pipes. The result is a refreshed building that is filled with light while maintaining the imprint of its past. Here you will encounter food from all over the world that is united by a focus on the techniques and cultures of the countryside: local ingredients, minimization of waste, a connection with the natural environment, and preservation techniques that take time, such as smoking and fermentation. **INSIDER TIP** Open for lunch only. They offer a 4-course menu that changes every week ranging from smoked trout to homemade sausages.
